CODE OF CONDUCT

As a judge for the Unwanted Witness Privacy Moot Court Competition, your role is critical in ensuring fairness, impartiality, and professionalism throughout the competition. To that end, you ought to abide by the following code of conduct:



IMPARTIALITY

You will remain impartial throughout the competition and make decisions based solely on the arguments and evidence presented before me. You will not allow your personal beliefs, biases, or preferences to influence your judgments.



FAIRNESS

You will ensure that all participants are given equal opportunities to present their arguments and that no participant is discriminated against based on their race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or any other personal characteristic.



RESPECT & PROFESSIONALISM

You will treat all participants, including the competitors, coaches, organizers, and other judges, with respect, professionalism and courtesy. You will refrain from making any inappropriate or derogatory comments, gestures or actions.



CONFIDENTIALITY

You will maintain the confidentiality of all information shared during the competition, including participants' personal information, arguments presented, and judges' deliberations.



TIMELESS

You will arrive on time for all scheduled sessions and will make every effort to ensure that the competition proceeds as scheduled.



COMMUNICATION

You will maintain the confidentiality of the moot court proceedings, including the arguments presented, and the discussions among the judges. You will not disclose any information about the proceedings outside of the competition.

FEEDBACK & CRITIQUE:

You will provide constructive feedback and critique to the competitors and coaches, highlighting their strengths and weaknesses, and providing suggestions for improvement.



ETHICS & INTEGRITY

You will maintain high standards of integrity and ethics in your role as a judge, avoiding conflicts of interest or any actions that may compromise your impartiality.

You will engage in continuous learning and improvement, seeking to expand your knowledge and understanding of privacy law, moot court advocacy, and related fields.
